However, there are no specific CPT codes for nerve grafting. It is also required for nerve conduction studies to detect demyelination. Doctors often use the median superficial sural artery and nerve to create a flap for correcting anomalies around the foot as well as the ankle.

(2) If a physician injects the superior medial and lateral branches and inferior medial branches of the left genicular nerve, only one UOS of CPT code 64450 (Injection, anesthetic agent; other peripheral nerve or branch) may be reported regardless of the number of injections needed to block this nerve and its branches.

Sural nerve damage may affect the motor functions, in other words, the ability to move the ankle and foot. Symptoms can be pain, burning sensations, numbness, and weakness.

For the second surgical case, I would suggest CPT 27870 for the arthrodesis, ankle, open (CPT 29899 for an arthroscopic ankle arthrodesis). I would also bill for the application of the external fixator (either CPT 20690 or 26092, depending on device type used).

Consider re-billing this procedure using the CPT 64782 (excision of nerve lesion, foot) which is probably closer to what was done than the excision of a nerve lesion (neuroma) of a major peripheral nerve of the limb. The CPT 64782 code should go through without denial.
