Teaching Shakespeare

To “get” one of Shakespeare’s plays you need to read it several times. Often the meaning of the text doesn’t emerge on the first reading. This is the same with most texts, but it is doubly so with Shakespearean drama because of its archaic language, dramatic forms, and ambiguous figurative language.
